Translations vs. Evaluations



Translations

- Do not: give you knowledge of student's relative performance or provide a recommendation for where/how to place this student in U.S. system
- Use: understanding what the foreign credential says

Evaluations

- Recommendation/interpretation of performance in home country
- Use: assessing student's performance, comparing int'l students to U.S. requirements & eligibility
